Treatment Assistance Program

Financial hardships shouldn't keep patients from getting the treatments they need, that's why we created the Komen Treatment Assistance Program. Eligible applicants may receive a \$300 award once per 12-month period to help with treatment related costs such as:

- Rent/Housing
- Utilities/Bills
- Side-effect management medication (e.g. pain, anti-nausea, etc.)
- Child care/elder care
- Oral treatment medication (e.g. chemotherapy, hormone therapy, etc.)
- Transportation to and from treatment
- Durable medical equipment (e.g. oxygen tank, walker, etc.)
- Lymphedema care and supplies
- Food or groceries
- Palliative care / Home health care
